## HOME VISITATION

#### 3254 visits provided to 225 families with 316 Children

88% of participants reported being connected to additional concrete supports More than 1800 referrals to other community services/resources were provided



#### CRISIS SERVICES

#### 25 Families with 47 children were supported during a crisis

94% of participants reported that their presenting crisis was resolved 100% of participants reported that their level of stress decreased after participating



#### SCHOOL BASED

#### 1546 Presentations were provided to 6290 Students

77% of high school students reported that they feel more confident talking to parents or other trusted adults about the topics covered in the presentation.

82% of students reported that they learned a lot from the education sessions that they did not already know.



#### THE NEST

#### 152 families purchased 1530 needed baby items

193,000 points were used, which is approximately \$12,860!

## Education

The Adolescent Sexual Health Program partnered with the Marshalltown Police Department and Juvenile Court Services to provide lunch hour presentations to local businesses. Information was provided about online safety for youth. A total of four presentations were provided to 77 adults.

## Family Fair

The Annual Healthy Family Fair was held at the Roundhouse, bringing together 30 local agencies and resources to provide information and activities for children and families. It is estimated that there were 1200 people in attendance!


